# IN-HOME TRAINING AND BEHAVIOR PROBLEM SOLVING CONSULTATIONS

<u>PUPPY HOUSEBREAKING ORIENTATION</u>: Steps to successfully housebreak your puppy and reduce puppy biting, organizing the puppy's living environment, developing a feeding schedule and teaching the puppy simple commands are discussed and implemented including your individual concerns.

Fee: \$90 (1 hour session)

# <u>PRIVATE TRAINING PACKAGES</u>

<u>PRIVATE TRAINING</u>: Private one-on-one sessions are helpful for people who prefer individual attention or as an adjunct to group classes. An individually tailored program to help you train your puppy or dog can be developed by Bob Burrud's Pet Services, Inc. Functional obedience training & behavioral issues may also be addressed.

## <u>FIRST CLASS</u>: Bring a comfortable chair and the *completed Fact Sheet, Contract Agreement and Fee (form online)*.

<u>VERY IMPORTANT</u>: Your dog must be current on all required vaccinations. It is suggested you seek your veterinarian's input on participation in a puppy class.

## **REMAINING CLASSES**: — please bring the following:

- Chair to sit on during lecture periods & a rug or mat to train your dog to "settle down".
- A securely fitting collar or harness & a six-foot leash.
- Tasty treats your dog loves. Preferably favorite yummy moist foods/treats (your dry dog food can be used for veracious eaters).
- A chew of your choice such as oversized rawhide, bully sticks, etc. To keep your dog busy during lecture periods.
- A sense of humor, your dog will appreciate it. Wear comfortable clothing and shoes (no flip flops). You will be active and may get a bit dusty.

We appreciate your interest in Bob Burrud's Pet Services, Inc. If you decide to enroll your dog in a class or an individual session, please observe the following guidelines to insure maximum success.

## Bob Burrud's Training Tips

### **In-Class Participation**

- Be on time!
- 2. Keep your dog on leash, unless specified by the instructor.
- 3. Keep your dog away from other dogs unless specified by the instructor.
- 4. Use approved training equipment. All vaccines must be current.
- 5. Wear non-distracting clothing & comfortable shoes.
- 6. Other family members are welcome but young children must be supervised by another adult. Your focus should be on training your dog.

## At-Home with your Dog

- 1. Practice\_obedience commands 30-minutes a day with your dog.
- 2. Have all capable family members' practice with your dog.
- 3. Consider spaying/neutering your dog.
- 4. Increase social contact time with your dog.
- 5. Consider having the dog sleep inside your home.
- 6. Keep food reinforcers hidden from the dog's sight.
- 7. Remember that your dog is always learning, so apply the concepts learned in class throughout your day.
